BASIC INFORMATION

- Duration: 8 days (arrival 23 May - 01 morning of June 2016)
- Venue: Commune de Trades (near Lyon)
- Groups: 6 young people plus 1 group leader (no limit age)
- Work language: English. But is not necessary a high communicative of English spoken level!

Summary of the Project

42 young people from France, Bulgaria, Estonia, Montenegro, Albania and Serbia who will visit Lyon, France will be involved in the project "Media for All" and will discuss the role of media in our societies and how media can increase youth participation. Together with our partners, we are looking forward to this exchange. The 42 young people will visit Lyon, from 23 may-1 June 2016, to reflect about the role of media and become journalists themselves for a couple of days.

On daily basis young people receive different information and messages and they need to develop critical thinking concerning all that information. From this point, the main goal of the project "Media for All" is developing abilities of young people. A very important role is given to the media today and they are prerequisites of democracy. Young people are often confused by different messages coming across from media and it is very important for young people to understand how media work, be able to work with information and process the information they get.

Young people will get the opportunity to become journalists and create newspapers, short videos and journalism photos are foreseen activities of this project. Everyone of the participants will be able to work in international groups, have to divide the tasks, learn how to use new tools, make interviews with local people and create together a final product.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES

- "Trip to Lyon"
We will have time to discover Lyon. This day will take packed lunch and we will spend time visiting the most important places of the city.
- "Meeting with the local authorities"
The municipality support the project which is developed by be active .
- "Open Space - Future Projects"
Time to get contact each other and share ideas for future projects. This is a very important space to create new networks between young people which have same interests. This space is for help to develop new ways to co-operation and establish realistic near future projects.

PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

- Age: 18 - 25 (if under 18 or between 25 and 30 let us know)
- 6 young participants from each country plus one group leader (who is not age limit Please, try to keep gender balance in your groups!! 2 -3 girls, 2 - 3 boys!
- Erasmus+ is a program which supports disadvantage young people, so we would like to make this project open for these young people with fewer opportunities, so do no hesitate to including people with fewer opportunities into your group! The accommodation is adapted to special needs, so there is no problem with this. If you are thinking or you know there will be people with some handicap in your group, please tell us as soon as possible just to have it in mind! And we will prioritize this people for selection.
- English is our work language, but is not obligation. We will have some meetings and discussions so it will be recommended at least basic knowledge or translation into your groups. Don't be afraid of language! We will find the way to solve it!
- People who is interested in the topic.
- Young people who share the volunteering spirit.
- Young, motivated, nice, cheerful, smiling participants and good mood!! 😊

YOUTHPASS

Each participant will receive YouthPass, wich:

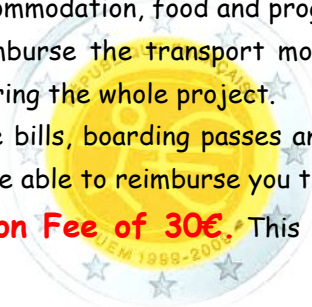
- Certificate of non-formal education (you will take part on an educational activity)
- You can include it in your CV and use it for school, university, new job, etc.

In the beginning of the project we will divided participants into a small groups that later will work every evening in the reflection groups where they'll talk about the day, activities, what they have learned, etc. With all these notes, at the end of the Exchange will be a workshop where the participants will work in their own YouthPass

YouthPass will be reached on the end of exchange.

MONEY

- AFSSC covers simple accommodation, food and program activities.
- **IMPORTANT:** We reimburse the transport money ONLY if the participant will ACTIVELY take part during the whole project.
- You have to keep all the bills, boarding passes and every type of ticket transport with you, so that we were able to reimburse you the costs.
- There is a **Participation Fee of 30€**. This is fee is obligatory to participate in the exchange.



TRANSPORT

- You must choose **the cheapest travel possibility** to Lyon
- The best option is to get flight to Lyon-Saint-Exupery. After this you need to take train to Mallevall en Vercors
- From these airport we will pick you and bring you to the place.
- PLEASE **contact us BEFORE buy your tickets**. Look for the best options and send it to us. When you receive it, you will be able to buy the tickets.
- As soon as possible after buy your tickets, **send us all you travel information** in order to give you more information.
- Finally, we will need all the information about your arrival and departure details in the moment you finish to buy all the transport tickets.
- We will keep the original transport tickets for your go travel and copies of your return tickets, but you **MUST** send the originals ones as soon as possible when you arrive home.

- We will talk about the rules directly at the place.

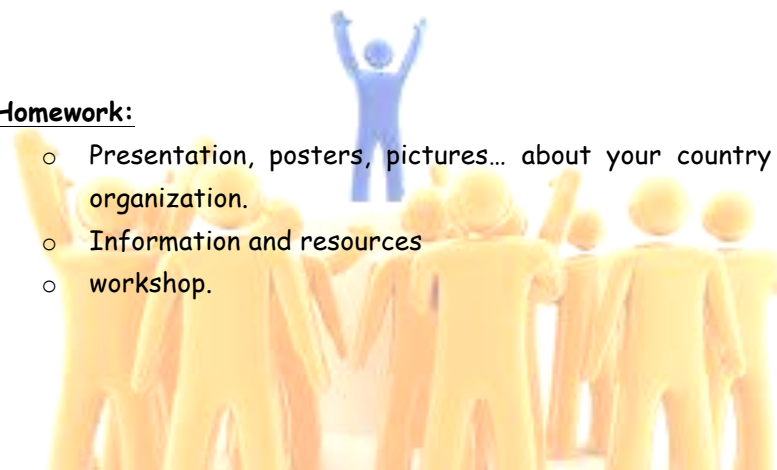
YOU WILL NEED...
